



“Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.”

Galatians 6:7

The apostle Paul is making a statement to the Galatians to not make the mistake of thinking that one can mock God in their own achievements. In other words, one cannot ridicule or belittle God in what they decide to do themselves. Whatsoever it is, is what a man sows in life. This is what he will also reap. Whether for good or bad. I am amazed at what I see in the world today. I hear the statement “as it was in the days of Noah,” and everyone shakes their head in agreement. However, we must take note that whatever a man or woman sows today, that is what they will reap. The word [reap] is the harvest in the field. This is a new way of understanding its meaning. 1 Timothy 6:10

Galatians 6:3

“Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.”

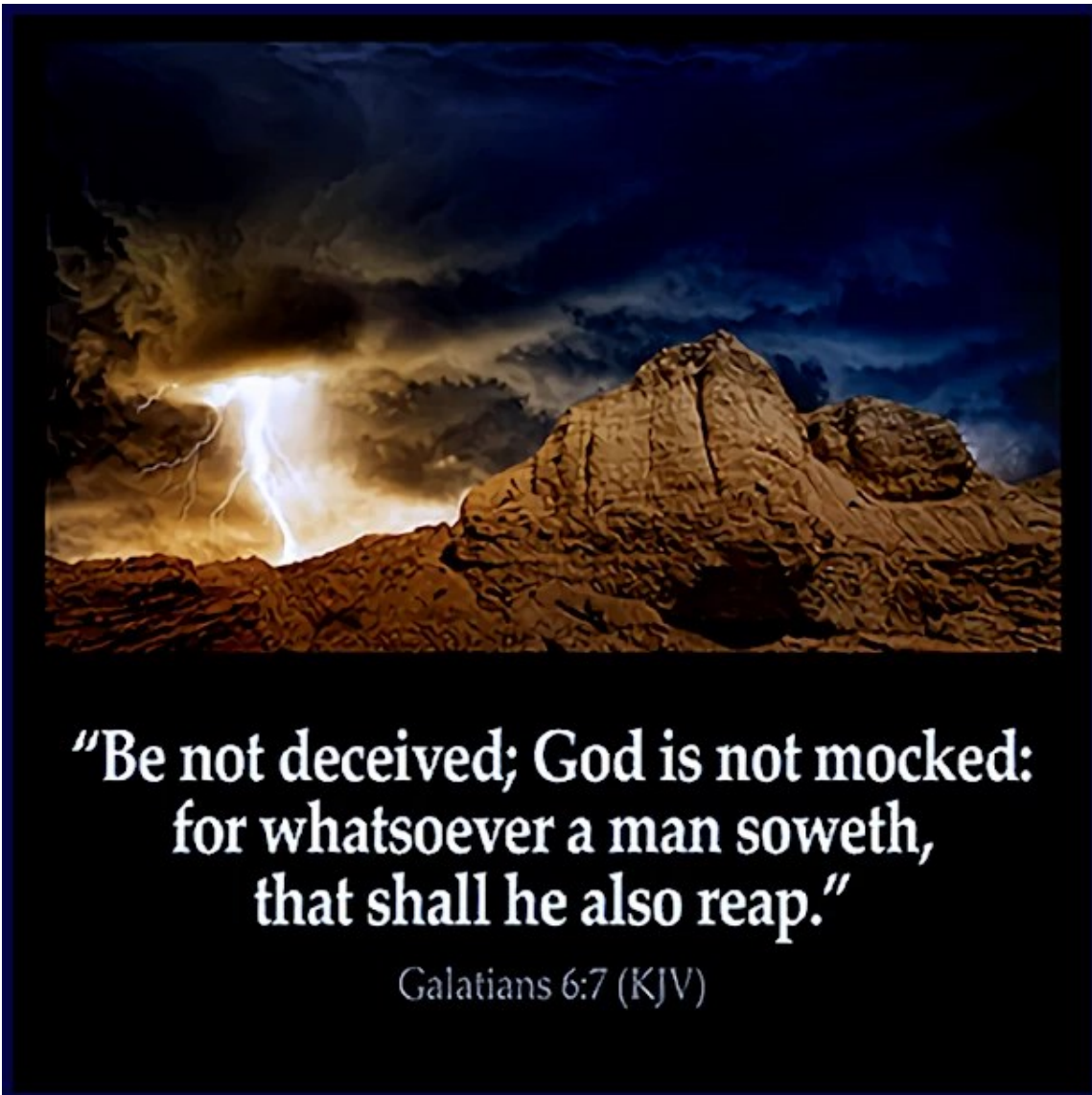
Psalms 55:22
