“For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones is as a storm against the wall.”  
Isaiah 25:4



Against the wall of evil is the storm, but the Lord will be our hope and strength. Purify your heart before the Lord and trust in Him.

day of judgment to be punished: But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. 2 Peter 2:8-10

However, God will restore the years that the locust hath eaten, [see Joel 2:25]. Now, look at verse 24 of chapter 2 of Joel that states the floors shall be full of wheat, and the vats shall overflow with wine and oil. "For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeketh after."
