



They prophesy falsely unto you in my name: I have not sent them, saith the LORD.

Jeremaiah 29:9

They have prophesy falsely in the name of the Lord. These messengers to the Jews. Prophets that were not prophets. These false prophets prophesied a “false vision and divination,” [see Jeremiah 14:14]. Elders along with prophets who were carried away captives into Babylon. We should be careful to what we listen to and not be carried away into captivity. Prophets are to speak the divine revelation or communication of God’s will. Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.”

1 John 4:1

These prophets deny who Christ is [the son of God come in the flesh]. They also deny Christ resurrection. Resurrection is restoring a dead person to life. Resurrection is eternal life. This we have through Christ. We are born again into His righteousness. There are distinguishing characteristics of a Christian, and practicing sin is not one of them. What did John say in chapter three? “He that committeth sin is of the devil.” [1John 3:8]. This was the purpose that the Son of God was manifested, that “he might destroy the works of the devil.”
